Project: Bobcat Fire - Post fire runoff and erosion control.

Client: Department of Earth Resources Colorado State University.

Type: University Research.

Description: Evaluated changes in runoff and erosion on burn-areas where Rescaype was applied.

Methodology: Direct, dry application.

Results: Treatment reduced sediment erosion by 80%, and sediment concentrations by 68%.

Applications: Furrow irrigation, construction dust suppression, slope erosion control, roadside re-vegetation.
